2. Review February PGAC Minutes: No issues.
3. Review February PLC Minutes: Dave D. reported on the PLC discussion on the 50th anniversary celebration for the church. If anyone from our commission wishes to volunteer for the celebration steering committee, contact Pat Rother. No issues otherwise.
4. Open Items from the February minutes:
 - Update on PLC meeting. See above.
 - No report on welcome desk volunteers from Jim. Marianne and Kathleen both mentioned they are new volunteers. More are needed.
 - Knights of Columbus Anniversary event at the 10:30 Mar. 12th mass was well done.
 - Knights of Columbus flag display proposal is now with the Arts and Environment Commission.
 - The old SJB school cross was reported as being so deteriorated it was destroyed. No further action.
 - Commission members are to review the proposed Mission, Vision & Values statement (Rita to send to those needing a copy). Fr. Skluzacek is to make input received the topic of the next PLC meeting. See the Parish Business Administrator's Report (passed out at our meeting).
 - As previously reported to the parish, Wines to Wishes was a great success, raising more than \$80,000.
5. Regarding the PBA report the 2017 FallFest was discussed. There is quite a bit of excitement over the initial plans.
6. The April Agenda is to be determined.
7. Other discussion items.
 - More hymnals have been ordered with newly donated funds. More Hymnals are still needed.
 - Discussed the library and their continued needs for space and better computer system.
 - No other liaison reports were made.
 - Dave D. reported on low water pressure on second level water fountains. Also is bringing to the PLC a proposal for installing several dual action drinking fountains (adding the ability to fill water bottles).
 - Finally, we discussed the fact that 3 commission members are approaching the end of their 3 year terms. These are Ralph, Glenda, and Jim. Ralph announced he will continue to serve another 3 years.
