- **PLC minutes from January 2016 meeting.**

  - **Review of first workshop for Lectors, Eucharistic Ministers and Musicians.**
    - Good turnout for the workshop. This may be something that needs to be done once a year.
      - Ushers/Greeters
        - Guide was very well received as a starting point.
        - Did a review of some of the changes being implemented.
          - Hosts have been found in various places throughout the sanctuary. Looking to find people to make sure Eucharist is consumed, "spotters".
          - Need to inform the parish of the new spotter position so everyone is aware.
        - Gave an overview of the AED device. Would like to have a more in-depth training session.
        - Currently looking at setting up regular training – every other month with a different topic – for the ushers, spotters and greeters.

- **Name and Topics for the worship column in the bulletin.**
  - Name possibility – "Worship Corner"
  - Jay will write about the topic to be published in the bulletin.
  - Include website links for a deeper understanding of the topic.
  - Possible topic:
    - We *Venerate* the Cross on Good Friday, we spend time in the *Adoration* Chapel and we come together on Sunday to *Worship*. What is the difference between these three: Veneration, Adoration, Worship.

- **Update of projects (Jay)**
  - Church & St. Joseph Hall lighting. Our light fixtures are being upgraded to DMX-level dimming capability at no charge to us—an \$10,840 value! (This was an alternate we had not chosen, but Stinson arranged to provide at no extra cost due to Stinson's relationship with lighting manufacturers.) The project will begin the first week of April, with both the church and St. Joseph Hall being upgraded simultaneously. Both locations should be complete by May 1.
  - The current communion cups have a curved lip which can cause problems with spills. Jay will look into alternatives and check on prices. Donation has been made – may not completely cover the cost. Others may wish to donate once prices are known.
  - Two new stained glass windows are being installed. Looking for a third donor to complete the windows.
