## Agenda

### Worship Commission – Discernment of new members

- Mary E and Mary Ann applied for the one open spot on the Worship Commission.
- Jill led us in prayer;
- All members stated why they were on the committee and discerned as to whether they wanted to remain or not. All members agreed to remain on the commission for the duration of their term.
- Mary Anne graciously withdrew her application. The Commission is open to Mary Ann applying again when a seat on the commission becomes available.
- Jill closed the discernment process with prayer.

### Project list for FallFest funds was presented to Fr. Skluzacek

- The main items are:
  - refinishing of the pews
  - new lighting in the church
  - scraping of the ceiling while retaining the sound of the spoken word
  - updating the sound system
- A priority list will need to be sent to the Administrative Services Commission for review.

### Music

- Fr Skluzacek provided his thoughts about the music for next year. Overall the current music situation has gone well; the majority of the feedback has been very positive. He is open to recommendations for next year.
- Combining different types of music for a given Mass is something to look into.
- The current pew missal has a limited selection of music. A decision regarding whether we will renew the pew missal or not will need to be made well in advance of the first week of Advent.
