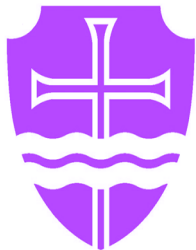

Hymns not found in Ritual Song, may be considered providing we have the necessary copyright permissions and space for song in the Mass leaflet.

Guest soloists are welcome to sing a solo selection or two. Experienced cantor's are required for Funeral Masses. St. John's will provide a cantor, however, guest soloists are welcome to participate in addition, especially as a prelude, or during the Preparation of the Gifts
