



A Message From Father Magner:

Greetings to all of you! I am very happy to join the parish of St. John the Baptist and, as a means of introduction, I've been asked to write this column to let you know a bit about myself.

I am a priest of the Archdiocese of St. Paul & Minneapolis; ordained May 31, 2003. I was born October 5, 1964 as the fifth child of John and Leona Magner. Along with five brothers and three sisters, I was raised in Delano—not very far from Fr. Paul's hometown of St. Michael. My home parish in Delano was the Church of St. Joseph, where I received the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation. (Those were still the days when the bishop would go to individual parishes for Confirmation.)

I graduated from Delano High School in 1983 and then attended the University of Minnesota, where I received a Bachelor of Science degree in the department of mortuary science. At that time in my life I had not yet considered a vocation to the priesthood but, instead, began my profession as a funeral director, which I did for 10 years at Gearty-Delmore Funeral Home in Robbinsdale.

It was during these years of working in the service of others that I began to experience a calling to a different kind of service. Through the encouragement of many priests that I knew I followed the calling to the Catholic priesthood and entered the seminary in 1997. I studied for two years in pretheology at the St. Paul Seminary and was then invited to continue formation at the North American College in Rome for the next four years. I was ordained a deacon at St. Peter's Basilica in Rome on October 10, 2002 by Bishop Timothy Dolan, and ordained a priest by Archbishop Harry Flynn at the St. Paul Cathedral on May 31, 2003.

Since my ordination I've served at several parishes in the Archdiocese, including Our Lady of Grace in Edina, St. Charles Borromeo in St. Anthony, and most recently at the parishes of Ss. Peter and Paul in Loretto and St. Thomas the Apostle in Corcoran.

In my personal time, I enjoy reading historical biographies, hiking, biking, trips to the North Shore, and spending time at the family cabin in Cold Spring.

So, that's me. I look forward to getting to know all of you and hearing your stories in our time together here at St. John the Baptist!


