### **Administrative Services Commission**

Mission Statement: It is the mission of the Administrative Services Commission to collaborate with parish staff to create a sacred place where all are welcome. This will extend to the physical plant and all properties owned by the parish. The Commission will create a safe, secure and welcoming environment that supports all of our parish ministries.

### **Evangelization and Stewardship Commission**

Mission Statement: Assist and support the Pastor in presenting the Bishops' vision of stewardship that suits the needs of our parish, diocese and Catholic Church in our country today and speaks to those who practice Christian stewardship in their particular circumstances. To be models of stewardship in all aspects of our lives; in our prayer and worship, in our stewardship of resources, in our lifestyle and use of time, and even in such matters as the attention we give to personal health and recreation. To evangelize and form disciples of Jesus Christ and carry out the parish mission of Go, Make, Teach through youth and adult faith formation, specific initiatives directed toward parishioners in various stages of their journey, and intentional inclusion of evangelization and stewardship themes within all parish activities in order to grow in awareness, understanding and practice of Christian evangelization and stewardship at St. John the Baptist Catholic Church.

### **Faith Formation Commission**

Mission Statement: Faith Formation is the continual process of discovering, unwrapping, examining and appreciating God's gift. It is overlapping and lifelong. A comprehensive faith formation process must be integrated into parish life. It is another way of saying that we learn our faith as we live it, in the midst of a celebrating community that proclaims Jesus' message in Word and action. Adults and children learn by doing.

### **Finance Commission**

Mission Statement: The mission of the Parish Finance Commission is to serve as a consultative body advising the Pastor in the prudent planning and administration of all parish financial matters and in the setting of policies and procedures intended to provide effective management of parish assets. The Parish Finance Commission is a mandated body that has an advisory and consultative role with the Pastor of the parish. An active, well-formed Finance Council is a key element for promoting the financial health of a parish, assuring accountability, and assisting the Pastor with his temporal responsibilities. While the Parish Finance Commission does not have decision making authority, consultation is at the heart of the decision making process for the administration and stewardship of the temporal goods of the parish. Therefore, the Pastor and the members of this Commission must be oriented to sharing information, listening, contributing to the discussion, and promoting consensus.

### **Parish Groups and Activities Commission**

Mission Statement: It is the mission of the Parish Groups and Activities Commission to assist ministries in the parish community that are cross-disciplinary in nature or offer specialized services: To enrich and deepen parish members' relationship to God; To GO reach out, MAKE disciples and TEACH others.

### **Pastoral Outreach Commission**

Mission Statement: Our mission is to engage the parish community in the mission of the church and continue the work of Christ in caring for those in need of physical, emotional, or spiritual care.

### **School Advisory Commission**

Mission Statement: It is the mission of St. John the Baptist's Parish school to educate the children in all aspects of their lives. This is done through formation in Catholic faith and values and quality instruction. We help children discover and live up to their full potential developing self-respect, respect for others, gratitude, and a sense of Christ-like service to the community in a JOY-filled (Jesus-Others-You) spirit.

### **Worship Commission**

Mission Statement: It is the mission of the Worship Commission to provide direction and support for worship ministers and ministries in ways that increase, enhance and encourage active participation in worship by all members of the parish community.
