

### **Going Up**

Both Elijah and Jesus go up the mountain and encounter God in the scriptures we read this weekend. This traditional image of going up reminds us of the invitation that God gives us. We are to go up to him by raising our minds and hearts up in prayer. In the sanctuary of most churches, the priests and other ministers must climb up steps to the altar and tabernacle, as a reminder that we are to go up to him. It is important for us to go up to him as we can often become distracted by our day to day tasks. In fact, during the pandemic, we are overwhelmed by the need to protect ourselves physically. We are tempted to become only focused on ourselves. Yet, God is inviting us to look outwards and upwards to him. He desires to be united to us in the Holy Spirit through prayer. He desires to unite our hearts and minds with his. Being united with him in prayer allows us to be strengthened and guided by him. He helps us persevere.

I recently had the opportunity to hike up Carlton Peak, a “mountain” near Lutsen, MN. At the top, I sat down to pray daytime prayer from the Liturgy of the Hours, which are the prayers that priests pray every day. The prayer was Psalm 23 and I prayed, “The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want. Fresh and green are the pastures where he gives me repose. Near restful waters he leads me, to revive my drooping spirit.”

The Lord met me on that mountain and spoke to me right there. I felt great comfort in praying those words. The green of the forest was spectacular and beyond the trees was the beautiful blue waters of Lake Superior. Now, this was not the image I typically think of when I read Psalm 23, as I think of a gentle stream and green grass filled with sheep. Yet, he was present right there in front of me in his creation. As I prayed the Psalm, I knew the Lord was speaking to me through the magnificent view from that mountain. I saw the green pastures and restful waters and felt God revive my drooping spirit. I sensed his love and his presence. I felt him lift my spirits as I grieve the loss of my grandmother. There was a remarkable sense of peace and strength that the Lord gave me in that moment. Shortly, after I finished my daytime prayer I hiked around the top of the peak, taking in the beautiful view. There, also at the top of the mountain, were two other Catholic priests from Fargo diocese! I felt like Jesus in the transfiguration, who met Moses and Elijah at the top of Mount Tabor! I really enjoyed being there and wanted to stay like Peter did, but I knew that I must come back down to our wonderful parish and serve here. In order to maintain that joy, I must continue to go up the mountain and pray. That does not mean climbing up Carlton Peak soon, but it does mean that I will climb the steps of the sanctuary to celebrate Mass and encounter the Lord. It does mean that I need to take time for prayer, to pause during the day, and raise my heart and mind from the various tasks and events to the presence of God.

Please also take time everyday to go up to God in prayer. Whether it is when you get out of bed in the morning, or on your drive to work, or before a meal, or before going to bed at night, take time to go up to God. He is there for you. Together, let us rely on prayer and be united in the Holy Spirit as we approach him! Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever. He is our shepherd, there is nothing we shall want. Fresh and green are the pastures where he gives us repose. Besides restful waters, he leads us to revive our drooping spirits.

Speaking of going up, on August 15th we celebrate Mary’s Assumption into heaven (not a holy day of obligation this year). Join fellow parishioners and the Knights of Columbus at 7pm in our West Parking Lot for a live rosary and bonfire! We will also attempt to live stream it on Facebook. We look forward to praying together! Contact me with any questions.

## Convent for Our Sisters

Over the past year our parish community has been blessed to host two sisters from the Dominican Sisters of the Most Holy Rosary of the Philippines, Sr. Leonarda and Sr. Ermelinda. (This year we are welcoming a third sister, Sr. Novie.) Several of our parish leaders worked hard to bring the sisters to our parish, find a suitable home for them, furnish it and help them move in back in August 2019. We rented a house for them less than a block from our church campus. This spring the owner of the home informed us that she would be selling the house and therefore not renewing our lease, which was set to expire on July 29. Then began a search by parish staff and the sisters themselves for a suitable home for the sisters proximate to St. John's. There were some promising leads, but we were unable to locate and secure a rental property. After several weeks of searching, we began to consider purchasing the home the parish was renting.

Ultimately that is what we did. St. John's purchased the home, closing on July 29. We followed Archdiocesan and parish protocols on obtaining input and approvals. The Finance Commission unanimously approved the purchase, and the Pastoral Leadership Council was consulted and member input was considered. Father Paul and our parish trustees, Gary Horn and Marian Briggs, all approved of the purchase. And, not least important, Archbishop Bernard Hebda and Vicar General Very Rev. Charles Lachowitzer also approved of the purchase.

The sale price of the house was \$248,050, which we believe is a fair market value. The house was inspected prior to purchase and several improvements were made by the seller as a result. Due to the inspection and the fact that we have rented the house for a year, we know the property fairly well. The parish decided to pay cash for the house, drawing from operating reserves, to avoid debt and save money on interest expense. Paying cash also saves us money in our operating budget this year, since we would have paid rent each month. And, it secures a home for the sisters and their order, with whom our church and school are developing a relationship for mutual benefit. Our parish leaders also reasoned that if for whatever reason our circumstances change, the parish can sell the house at some point in the future, likely for a gain. And, another factor in making this decision is that our preliminary June 30, 2020 fiscal year end financials show that we will land significantly in the black, thanks to our parishioners' continued generosity, even in the midst of this pandemic. 
