Good Worship Question – revisiting - Lee is considering starting the “Good Worship” question. We discussed the various channels we should use for this. Originally it was in the weekly bulletin. With all the changes, we discussed how to reach different parishioner age groups in different channels. Channels would include Bulletin, Facebook, Email, Pastor Newsletter, Flocknote, YouTube, webpage, and likely others. A subcommittee will work with Lee to determine the optimal channels to use, starting out with just a few channels.

Mosaic - Mosaic project was brought up, in the sanctuary on the vertical wall above the triptych and tabernacle, with a number of saints and blessed on either side of Christ. Nick Markell, who has written icons and designed stained glass windows in the nave, did a scale drawing of this. There was some initial interest last year and apparently funds pledged toward the project. The Worship Commission considers this a major project for the beauty of the nave, but at a lower priority.
