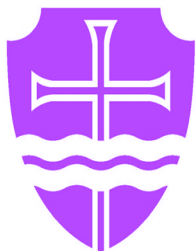

4. Music during the reception of Holy Communion

The Director of Worship reserves the right to place all music selections according to where it best fits in the Mass Leaflet.

+ During the Seasons of Advent and Christmastide, Lent and Eastertide, music selections should reflect that of the season.

The parish will provide at no charge to the family a Mass leaflet containing the Order of Worship. Anything in addition to the leaflet, such as a Prayer Card is provided by the funeral chapel and/or the family.

Hymns not found in Ritual Song, may be considered providing we have the necessary copyright permissions and space for song in the Mass leaflet.

Guest soloists are welcome to sing a solo selection or two. Experienced cantors are required for Funeral Masses. St. John's will provide a cantor, however, guest soloists are welcome to participate in addition, especially as a prelude, or during the Preparation of the Gifts

Pre-recorded music is not allowed during the Liturgy.
