

## The Trinity: The Ultimate Love Song

When we stop and think about active participation in the Mass, singing of hymns can be the first thing that comes to many people's minds. Even singing the Mass Ordinaries, texts of the Mass that stay the same each week, such as the Gloria, Kyrie, and Sanctus, may come up as a priority. While all of these are important, the Church emphasizes that the Dialogues of the Mass are the most important part to sing. A Dialogue in the Mass is when words go back and forth between two persons, the Head, the priest, and the Body, the people. The first dialogue in the Mass is the Sign of the Cross, with the celebrant saying, "in the name of the Father..." as the people respond "Amen". The second would be the Greeting, with the celebrant saying, "the Lord be with you" as the people respond, "and with your spirit". The Dialogues continue throughout both the Liturgies of the Word and Eucharist. Anytime words are going back and forth between two persons, it is a dialogue, compared to a hymn, which is a monologue. This is so important that according to a crucial Church document on music, *Musicam Sacram, Instruction on Music in the Liturgy*, the Church gives three degrees in order of importance at Mass with the Dialogues as first degree, Ordinaries as second degree and hymns and Mass Propers (i.e. Introit, Communio) as third degree. The reason the Church emphasizes the importance of singing the Dialogues is because the Trinity is a love song between the Church, the bride and, Christ, the bride groom, which is expressed in the Mass, emphasizing this loving relationship.

How is the Trinity a love song? When we sing the Mass, we are singing as a Body talking to the Head and then together, talking to the Father, which helps us enter into both the liturgical action and text. In our culture we would not speak a love song to someone, just as we would not speak the song *Happy Birthday* to someone. We would sing it, emphasizing the importance of the text and what better to emphasize the importance of than the ultimate love song, the Trinity. As someone put it, "the Trinity is this eternal love song, the most perfect, true, substantial, meaningful, beautiful Word ever, combining with the breath of the Holy Spirit in this beautiful song of love. Therefore, the Trinity itself is a song of praise, love and devotion to God the Father." This love song is sacramentalized in the things we sing. Also, when we sing the Mass, the whole Church, saints, and people of God who have gone before us are with us, emphasizing the beauty and universality of the Church.

Since the Mass is a heavenly liturgy, we try to replicate it as much as possible in our liturgies. According to the Catechism, "those in heaven are recapitulated under the headship of Christ." The importance of singing is highlighted throughout many Church documents, such as *Musicam Sacram*, which states, "indeed, through this form, prayer is expressed in a more attractive way, the mystery of the liturgy, with its hierarchical and community nature, is more openly shown, the unity of hearts is more profoundly achieved by the union of voices, minds are more easily raised to heavenly things by the beauty of the sacred rites, and the whole celebration more clearly prefigures that heavenly liturgy which is enacted in the holy city of Jerusalem." This holds true to the Ordinaries and Propers as well.

Singing the Mass is the norm. Therefore, do not sing *at* Mass, but sing *the* Mass. Sing this song of love to our Father, with the breath of the Holy Spirit, who wants to be in relation with us through this exchange of love.

## COVID Protocol Updates

Based on guidance from the Minnesota Department of Health and Center for Disease Controls, face masks are recommended, but not required, to be worn at St. John the Baptist Church.






