From the Pastor: Father Paul Shovelain



Restoring is happening! Have you noticed it? Have you felt it? Christ is restoring us to life here at St. John the Baptist Catholic Church and School. We had a fantastic FallFest in September and people came out in great numbers. It was beautiful to see relationships being restored and people coming out and getting to know each other. We also saw a good response to the invitation to willingness to grow. Not only is our school growing, but our

Faith Formation program has more students enrolled this year than we did 2 years ago. It is beautiful to see families coming together to be restored to life in Christ. We also had a strong response to be willing to grow and helping our parish and diocese grow by participating in the Synod process. We have over 150 parishioners participating in these sessions, and I have enjoyed listening to our parishioners and hearing about their experience of Christ and ideas for what we can do to share His message.







FallFest 2021 Financial Report

As you can see in the table above, our financial results from this year's festival were nothing short of amazing! These results are preliminary, because some expenses are still based on estimates. However, we anticipate that the actual results will not differ substantially from what you see here.

Our festival net overall is up 12% (\$10,000) over 2020! Wow! In previous bulletins we thanked the many volunteers, staff and sponsors who made this festival so successful. Again, we say thank you to all who contributed to the success of our 2021 FallFest, which was a great occasion for our parish community to be Restored to Life!

A portion (\$30,000) of our festival proceeds will support all of our ministries through our operating budget. The balance will go to our capital reserves to support restoring our campus and its infrastructure, which supports our parish being restored to life this year as well.

We were blessed with good weather, amazing volunteers and a powerful SJB community spirit that one could feel at the festival. We are grateful to God for the many ways He is restoring us to life at St. John's this year, including at our parish festival!
