

This Sunday we celebrate Gaudete Sunday or Rejoice Sunday as Christmas is near. The closeness of Christ gives rise to joy in our hearts and minds. He is near us. As we celebrate together this weekend, we pray that we may sense the closeness of Christ and the deep love that He has for us personally. In that awareness, we are Restored to Joy and able to celebrate with gladness His coming at Christmas.

Senior Sparks Advent Party


The CCW and Widows/Widowers Group are cosponsoring an Advent Party for Seniors on Saturday, December 18th!






