- 4) Principal's Update
 - a. MNSAA and School Goals were referenced; SAC goal will link with some of these goals; Subject level goals are still being finalized
 - b. Curriculum – Specialists are reviewing their curriculum; REACH program is expanded to grades 5 and up; Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is moving along in PS with our focus on the Atrium
 - c. PD focusing on instructional coaching, differentiated instruction, student engagement, and discipleship in the classroom

 - a. SAC wants to know average family size to check on our multi child discount.
 - b. Also wanted to know average rate of inflation. COLA increase was confirmed by Mark Dittman later that week.
2. Reviewed proposal for 2.5% increase but we are concern about increased costs and COLA increase of 6%. SAC feels strongly that staff need to be compensated more than usual to offset inflation and COLA increase.
3. Suggested proposing 2 tuition and fee increases to Finance Council for next month's meeting. SAC will review the proposals as well and give a recommendation to Father.

Other: Discussed Middle Events for students to socialize; what is appropriate to offer in house and what can parents do on their own? There are some events and opportunities planned for Middle School students coming up, but parents can also create their own out of school opportunities.

Meeting Minutes 1/18/22

Prayer

Principals Update

1. Beginning to think about next year's budget and preparing for enrollment.
2. COVID Update: Cases are up since 1/3/22 and have had to increase mitigation for 2 grades this week.
3. NWEA testing in February.
4. Catholic Schools Week coming up but there are some concerns about bigger events.

Marketing

1. K-8 Enrollment = 332 - 3 starting next trimester and more families looking, according to the funnel K enrollment should be strong. Have had a several K tours for next year.
2. Marketing: PS & K Parent Information Night – 1/20 and a couple of SAC volunteers are needed.
3. W2W 2022: Invitations are out but registration is slow and discussed how to increase it. Report on sponsorship which do not seem impacted by the increase. Getting some bigger items for the auction. Auctioneer has been hired and things are coming together.

New Business: Tuition and Fees for 2022-2023

1. Reviewed CDC new guidelines for COVID isolation. It was decided that we should move to 5 days, and it is not unreasonable to ask them to wear a mask for the next 5 days or stay home for the dull 10 days. It was also decided that we would move to a 10 quarantine for positive household exposure. All opposed separating students for lunch when they returned 5 days after positive COVID.
2. CSW Variety Show was discussed. We talked about options if COVID continued to rise.
