Old Business

Recap of PLC meeting last month – Pat R.

Update of Chapel of Angels Renovation Project – Michael/Greg

Commission members of subcommittee gave updates from latest meeting. Leadership likes the latest revisions feeling that this design creates a more traditional yet unique look and feel. Some subcommittee and Worship Commission members also like the design. Raised surface for sanctuary may be an issue with in-floor heating. Michael and Jill on the Subcommittee raised concerns about the façade and the “text” in the sanctuary as well as where the musicians and organ are placed. An option is being considered to replace the pews. Overall, some members of the Subcommittee members have some concerns with this version of design while the majority either liked or accepted the revised design. These were discussed in our meeting. Michael would like to see the Worship Commission more engaged through our feedback that can be brought back to Subcommittee meetings. We reminded ourselves that we are an advisory committee. The plan is to present this renovation to the parish at large in April.

Church Interior Committee Update

Lee presented a sound system and acoustics report This issue is not likely to be considered until FY 2023. Other commissions are still working on other prerequisite items.

Holy Week Is coming up with Palm Sunday and the Triduum.

Update on other goals/goals follow up volunteer/assignment

Commission discussed goals on our worksheet. We talked about Minister training; some don't want to participate. How do we handle that? Let it slide or remove them from the ministry?

More requirements are considered being asked of ushers.

How do we accommodate this?

Use of defibrillator, watching unaccompanied children, helping persons in medical distress, for example. How do we train persons for this? Lee recommended that he follow up with some of the core ushers at the 8:30 AM mass and see if he can get some commitment that they take training. Discussion to be continued...
