From the Pastor: Father Paul Shovelain

Jesus Christ is alive!

The Son of God is alive and He is with us! He defeated sin on the cross and thus opened up the gates of Heaven for those who have died. One of my favorite pieces of art is Fra Angelico's "Descent into Hell." In the beautiful fresco, Jesus Christ bursts open the door to those awaiting entry into Heaven, including Moses and other Old Testament figures and He invites them to follow Him to Heaven. Some say the powerful Christ boldly states, "I'm here for My dad" as He bursts in to free them and lead St. Joseph and others to Heaven. This image and the Resurrection itself gives us great hope!

We are not made to live on Earth forever. Rather we are made for Heaven. Jesus is the new Moses Who leads us through the desert on this new exodus to the promised land of Heaven. He feeds us not with manna, but with His Body and Blood that remain with us to nourish us on the journey. He is leader and intercessor as Moses was. He boldly leads us to Heaven and supports us along the way. As we celebrate the Easter Season, we will reflect on the Eucharist and how it supports us as we journey through the desert. We are tempted like the Israelites to go back to Egypt, that is the place of slavery to sin, in hopes of finding comfort. However, we are called to live in freedom which the grace of the Eucharist helps us to do. With Christ, we can freely and purely love God and others. Christ helps us to root out selfishness and sin as we grow in holiness, and reflect Christ more fully to our broken world. As we grow in union with God, we are "Restored to Life" and help others be restored, as well.



The Resurrection of Christ beautifully points out the importance of our theme this year, "Restored to Life." Christ isn't restored to how He was before, but rather is glorified and exalted. God desires to raise us up. He desires our good and wants to always lift us up. May we be encouraged by that desire to trust ourselves more fully to Him this Easter season, as He "Restores us to Life!"

Even though I have been back for just a short time, it is beautiful to see Jesus Christ alive so powerfully in you! It was great to see so many families helping families at our service night on March 31st. We prayed for those in need and served them by putting together various items that will bring joy and love. I witnessed Christ in your willingness to grow at Family Formation, as well as our students in our school. I was also grateful to see Christ's generous spirit lived out in our Knights of Columbus in the fantastic fish fry they hosted. I also witnessed the reliance on prayer at the beautiful Holy Week liturgies. Christ is alive and present in you here at SJB!
