#### **Supreme Court Decision**

On November 10, 1942, Winston Churchill said this: "Now this is not the end. It is not even the beginning of the end. But, it is perhaps, the end of the beginning." I be-

lieve this is where we are today with regards to building a culture of life and ending abortion. I was thrilled to hear about the 6-3 Supreme Court ruling on Dobbs vs. Jackson Women's Health Organization which overturned Roe vs Wade. The decision puts the power to decide on the legality of abortions back into the state's authority. Unfortunately, for us in Minnesota, nothing has really changed in regards to outlawing abortion and protecting the lives of the unborn. However, knowing that we have the ability to protect the unborn now at the state level, it is all the more important to elect pro-life officials who will work to defend and protect ALL Minnesotans, especially the unborn and the vulnerable. I am so proud of those of you who have worked for almost 50 years to over turn Roe vs Wade. I am grateful for your dedication to protecting life and we stand with you as a parish. We want to build a culture of life, and hence we are just beginning our Baby Gift Tree, that will collect items for mothers in difficult pregnancy situations. Thank you for your donations and helping us to build a culture of life. Please also pray for our elected leaders. May they see the gift of every human person and work to protect all human life, especially human life in the womb.

If you have been impacted by abortion, know that we are here to help you and pray for you. Whether you had an abortion, or someone you know did, we want to help you. We desire your healing and we trust in the mercy of God. Please reach out to the parish and we can help you find the appropriate re-

sources to help with your journey of healing.



NFP is the natural and scientific way of observing a woman's signs of fertility in order to achieve and avoid a pregnancy. It teaches that fertility and sexuality are gifts that are to be appreciated, instead of being suppressed. Additionally, it is an acceptable method of family planning according to church teaching.

NFP can also assist women in uncovering the underlying causes of premenstrual syndrome (PMS), pelvic pain caused by endometriosis, repeat miscarriages, and infertility. With the use of natural, cooperative healthcare, women can often find relief and answers.



# SJB Year in Review Highlights for 2021-2022 "Restored to Life"

#### **Reliance on Prayer:**

- Over 100 participants attended the "Preparing for Heaven Seminar", in October- Father Paul's presentation, "Restored to Eternal Life with the Sacraments" encouraged reliance on prayer and the Sacraments. Five presentations from this event were videotaped and are posted on the new Legacy Society webpage https://stjohnnb.com/donate/legacy-society/
- † 1,300 copies of The Wisdom of Fulton Sheen were distributed at Christmas Masses with a special card featuring a "Prayer to be Restored to Life," and the SJB Mother of God icon.
- t Mass will be offered for the 137 members of St. John the Baptist Legacy Society on Thursday, June 23rd, the Feast of the Nativity of St. John the Baptist.
- † Parish Groups and Activities Commission provided definition of ministry that helps align our activities with our mission.
- † Resumed bringing Eucharist to the homebound, hospitals, and nursing homes.
- † Trainings were held for new Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion to the homebound.
- † Quilters distributed blessed quilt blankets to the community and to Sharing and Caring Hands.
- † Chapel of Angels is being renovated to better accommodate the spiritual needs of the Parish.
- † Livestreamed liturgies, funerals, Litany of Restoration, weddings, funerals, and other events through Facebook, YouTube, and NineNorth.
- † A Faith, Family, and Fellowship event was held for each grade level showcasing our students' talents.
- † Over 30 parishioners participated in 40 days of Life, praying outside Planned Parenthood.
- † The Faith in Football Camp had over 110 participants.
- † A parishioner from Saint John's received the "Leading With Faith" award from the Archdiocese of Saint Paul and Minneapolis.
