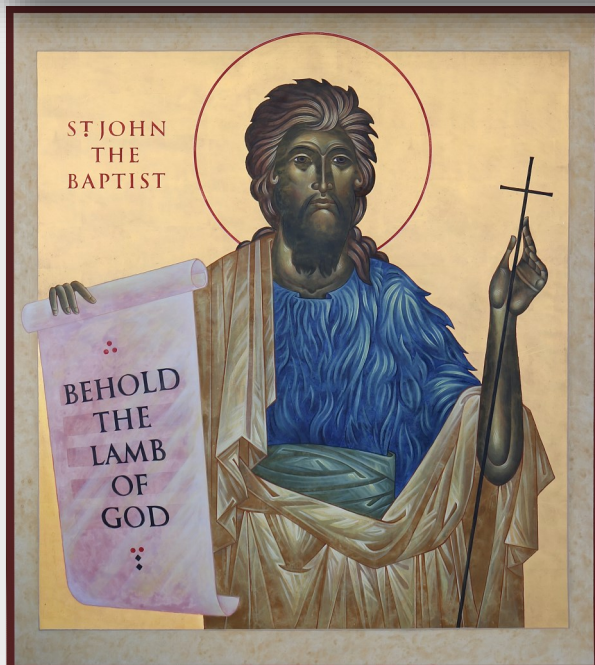
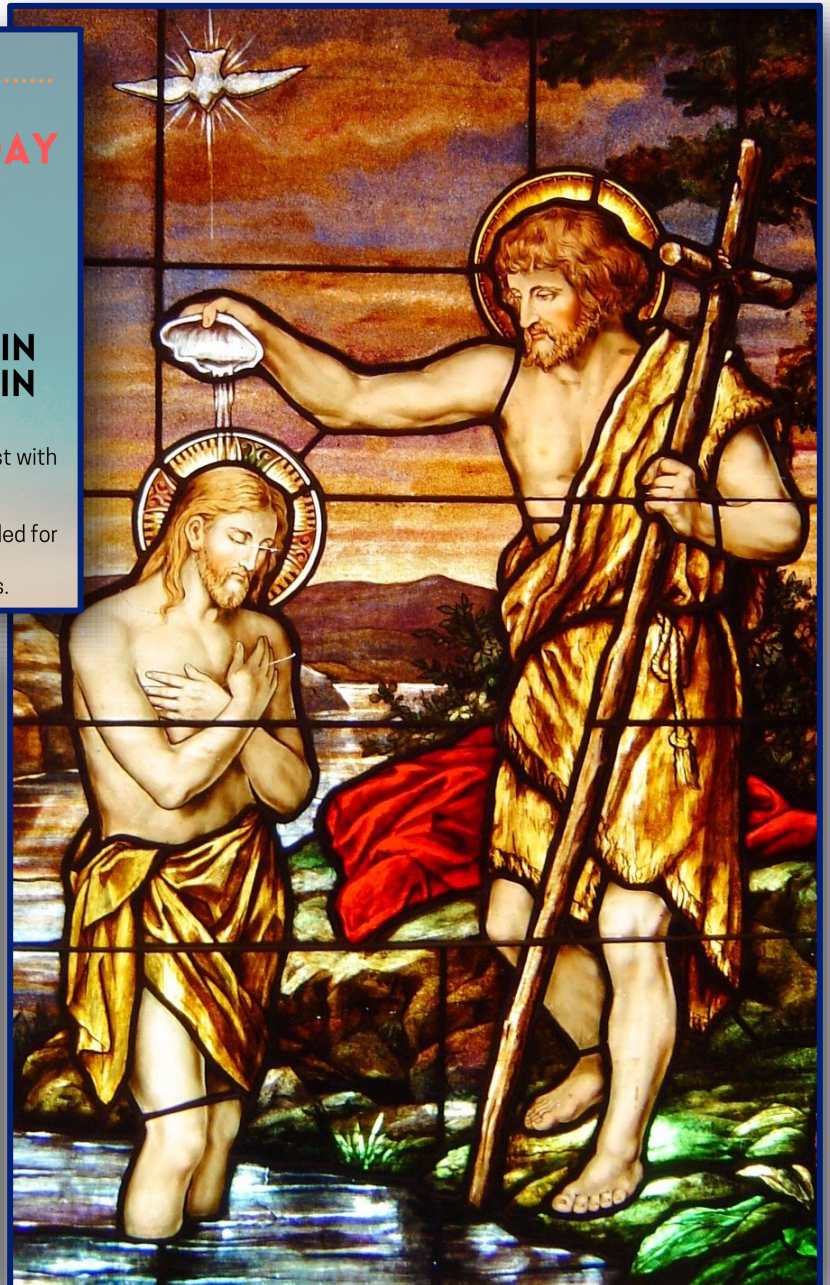

From Father Ben Snyder, Teaching Parish Seminarian

*“But He answered him, ‘Let the dead bury their dead.
But you, go and proclaim the kingdom of God.’”*

Four years ago, I met Fr. Paul at the seminary for a meet and greet with our future pastors. Soon after, I was at SJB for the first time at the Fall Fest and even helping out with the bags tournament, not knowing a single person. Four year later, I am now a priest and SJB is a place that feels like home, even though I will serve the people of Davenport, Iowa.

During my time at SJB, I have done a lot of things and been part of a lot of things from Fall Fest to youth group with the NET team, Family Formation, Sunday Masses, Teaching parish committee meetings once a month, parish commission meetings, Catholic Watchmen, RCIA, and (this last year) preaching and Baptisms. Basically, I have done a little bit of everything.

Coming from Davenport, which is a more rural diocese, SJB is larger than any parish back home, and I wondered how I would be able to integrate, especially since seminary demanded my time as well. However, I found that the community at SJB is very welcoming.

Ultimately, I found that this comes from the fact that SJB really is a parish on fire for discipleship rooted in Jesus. We had many conferences and talks in seminary about how to build a connected, on fire parish for discipleship and what one would look like. Many struggled to see or have a context of what that could look like. Not for me. I could point to my experience at St. John the Baptist.

I think a lot of that has to do with the great priests you have had and who I have gotten to know over the years. Fr. Skluzacek was there my first year and has become a mentor priest I look up to as a model pastor. I have seen how Fr. Paul truly loves being a priest and his desire to be present to everyone was especially evident through the lockdown times.

I am grateful to God that I was placed at SJB these last four years, most especially for all I have received from you. Your prayers, friendship, and welcoming me into your community has allowed me to grow. I am excited to bring what I have learned from you to the people in the diocese of Davenport. Know of my prayers, and please keep me in yours.
