## *From Parochial Vicar: Father Joseph Nguyễn*

“Lord, teach us to pray just as John taught his disciples.” He said to them, “When you pray, say: Father, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come. Give us each day our daily bread and forgive us our sins for we ourselves forgive everyone in debt to us, and do not subject us to the final test.”

In this weekend’s Gospel, Jesus teaches his disciples how to pray the Our Father. Since then, the Our Father has been a unifying prayer for all Christians. No matter the denomination, those who follow Christ all share one prayer in common. Typically, we each stay rooted in our respective practice of Christianity because of different understandings of doctrine, but I am always delighted to see fellow Christians come together to work and build the kingdom of God. There is an instinctual understanding of our unity as one body because we all follow Christ as our head, and wherever the head leads, we as the body follow. As the head, Jesus teaches us that God is our father, and if He is our father, then we are all His children.

The image of a father and his children is powerful because even though the children may fight and compete amongst themselves, the father is the one that unites them. This can be seen in biblical stories like that of Jacob and Esau, of Joseph and his brothers, or even of the disciples who quarrel among themselves to see who is the greatest.

As Christians, we share in Christ’s prayer of unity that he prayed at the Last Supper. “I pray not only for them, but also for those who will believe in me through their word, so that they may all be one, as you, Father, are in me and I in you, that they also may be in us, that the world may believe that you sent me.” We hope for the day when we all share in the fullness of truth and live in unity with each other. Professing God as our Father, following the example and prayer of Jesus Christ, our head.

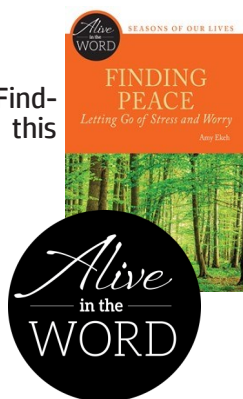

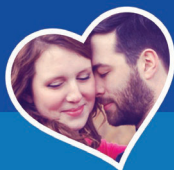

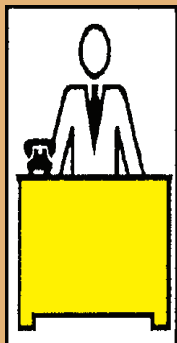
