Called Forth

As we reflect back on the last three years here at St. John the Baptist, there have been so many grace-filled moments. Our themes were “Inviting In,” “United in the Holy Spirit,” and “Restored to Life.” It was beautiful to see these themes embraced and bring vibrancy to our parish community. These were more internally focused themes, especially as we navigated the pandemic. Having focused internally, I am feeling led by the Holy Spirit to focus on mission. In 2022-2023, we are being “Called Forth.” It is both an invitation and an accompaniment. The Lord is calling us to take the next step on the journey of faith to become a saint. He is also meeting us where we are at in that calling. There is an intimacy and closeness in the calling. He is not dictating or forcing, but calling us in love to deeper communion with Him. In that deeper communion, we participate further in Christ’s mission to build up His kingdom.

Looking at the year, we will reflect on being “Called Forth” from the heart of the Father. The starting place is the Father, as every good thing comes from Him. His heart is powerful and consoling. It is where we experience confidence and hope knowing that He is a loving Father who cares for us. We can trust Him and lean on Him in mission.

Then, we will move into being “Called Forth” in deeper communion with the Son. It is Christ that perfects us, as His grace transforms us. As we allow Him to reign in our hearts and minds, we are strengthened and desire to share Him with others.

Finally, we will move into being “Called Forth” into mission by the Holy Spirit. The Third Person of the Trinity leads us to live life to the full. He is our guide and opens doors for us to build up Christ’s kingdom. He guides us to the Truth and leads us to Heaven. It is important to be led by the Holy Spirit to reach the destination to which we are called.

In the months ahead, we will develop the theme of “Called Forth” in these areas. Begin to think about where are you being “Called Forth” on the path of holiness? What is holding you back? Where would you like to grow? Having been “Restored to Life”, let us courageously move forward in faith, as we are “Called Forth” to build up Christ’s kingdom in New Brighton and beyond.

RCIC (Rite of Christian Initiation of Children) is for children between ages 8 and 14 who have completed 2nd grade and are looking to celebrate the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and First Reconciliation. Becoming Catholic RCIA Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults



RCIA is the process by which adult men and women are initiated into the Catholic Church through the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation. Baptized adults also are welcome to complete initiation sacraments. Participants receive Catechetical instruction, Scripture reflection, faith sharing, prayer, and liturgical rites aimed at helping participants be strengthened spiritually, and at the proper time receive the sacraments fruitfully. First Sacraments

The preparation for the sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Communion are completed during second grade. 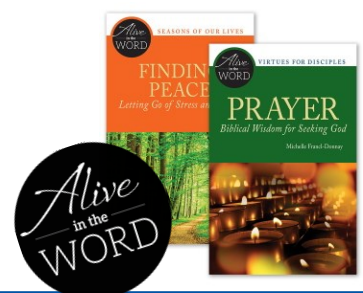

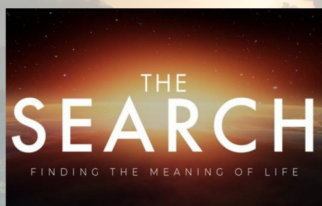

Sunday Giving Summary June 2022

- For the month of June 2022, Sunday Giving was 1% below budget.
- We ended the fiscal year with Sunday Giving at 1% below budgeted, July through June.
- For the 2021/22 fiscal year, we budgeted a 5.6% increase in Sunday Giving over actual 2020/21 giving. Sunday Giving for the fiscal year came in at 4.5%, or \$98,868, more than the actual Sunday Giving total for 2020/21. We fell short of our projected budget, but still saw a sizable increase in Sunday Giving.
- For the new fiscal year, 2022/23, we are budgeting a 2.5%, or \$57,443, increase over the 2021/22 total.

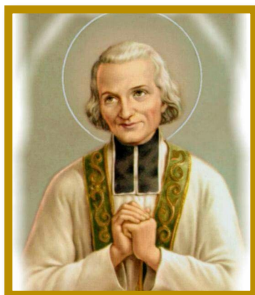

Help for Struggling Couples

Twin Cities Retrouvaille August 5—7, Best Western Hotel, Eagan. Retrouvaille has been a lifeline for troubled marriages. Since 1977, over 40,000 marriages have been saved worldwide. 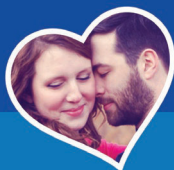

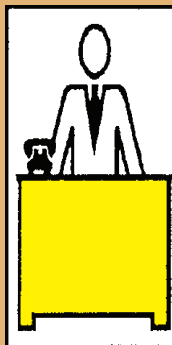
