

From the Director of Catechesis: Jill Fink



Our youth ministry program has grown and flourished over the last few years with Mikayla Anderson as our Youth Minister and the addition of NET Teams. As the continued plan to keep our youth programs thriving, we have restructured the youth discipleship areas into two positions, separating the ministry opportunities by age group to better serve our youth and expand into young adult ministry.

Mikayla Anderson's new title is Coordinator of Discipleship for High School Youth and Confirmation. She will minister to our families with youth in grades 9-12, building upon Discipleship groups, Wednesday youth group nights, retreats, prayer experiences and service opportunities as well as leading up our confirmation program on Sunday night.

To minister to our families with youth in grades 6-8 and young adults, I join the strong recommendation from our hiring committees to announce **Sarah Wilder** as our new **Coordinator of Discipleship for Middle School Youth and Young Adult Ministry**. The position will include Middle School Formation on Wednesday evenings, Middle School Youth Ministry throughout the year and Catholic Youth Summer Camp. The position will expand to include campus ministry opportunities in our middle school and begin to minister to young adults in the parish. Sarah writes the following:



"Hello! My name is Sarah Wilder and I am delighted to join the SJB community as the new Coordinator of Discipleship for Middle School Youth and Young Adults! I grew up in Faribault, MN attending Mass weekly with my family at Divine Mercy Catholic Church. When I was in late elementary school NET Ministries piloted a new experimental aspect of their ministry—the first parish/discipleship team. I was 12 years old when NET sent its final NET Team to our parish. Through their ministry, I came to a deeper experience of God and my Catholic faith. My love for God and His Church just came alive.

Since then, I have been actively involved in helping youth and young adults encounter Him whom I love. After high school, I became a NET missionary for two years. During my first year, I traveled the country putting on retreats for teens grade 6-12 to help them grow in their faith. Then, for my second year I was placed on a parish team in Plano, TX where I was invited to focus my attention on middle school youth.

After NET, I studied Theology and Evangelization & Catechesis at Benedictine College in Atchison, KS. During college I was active in evangelization and walked closely with many young adults as we sought the Lord together through shared life, continued formation and prayer. Since graduating in 2020 I have been working as a middle school teacher at St. Croix Catholic School where I taught Religion and Science.

When I am not at church or school, I enjoy spending time with friends, canoeing and hiking, playing board games or cards, and personal study. Do not be afraid to introduce yourself to me! I cannot wait to meet you!"

Rite of Christian Initiation for Children

RCIC (Rite of Christian Initiation of Children) is for children between ages 8 and 14 who have completed second grade and are looking to celebrate the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and First Reconciliation. Students who have been baptized and are in need of Eucharist and First Reconciliation are also welcomed. Parents accompany the child in the process with regular meetings.
