From Director of Parish Life; Jessica Balzarini

St. John's desires to "Reach More" people for Christ as we live out our Mission Statement to Go. Make. Teach. We continue to grow in numbers here at St. John's with new families in our school, the church programs for families, children and youth, and of course, the new families joining the parish each month. Because of this, our discipleship ministry for adults continues to expand in order to keep pace with all this growth.

Our local "Reach More" process has expanded quickly in the first three years of growth. We have helped over 50 already established disciples grow in holiness, deepen their prayer life, and wrestle with the Church's mission of evangelization, and their own call as lay (non-clergy) disciples to be missionaries in our own homes, with friends, in their neighborhoods, and at work. Many have gone on to do the work of evangelization and catechesis in small groups and one-on-one discipleship mentoring. Some have stayed with adult small groups and some used the knowledge and skills learned to benefit other ministries in the parish like RCIA, youth group, or Confirmation preparation. Each Lent we have about 150-200 parishioners in small groups with about 75 in small groups consistently throughout the year.

We welcome Claire Brostrom as the new Reach More Coordinator. She will be the point person for this expanding ministry, leading 2 Mission Training Groups this year, shepherding our leaders, and helping leaders with small group logistics.



"Thank you SJB parishioners for your warm welcome! My name is Claire Brostrom, and I could not be more excited to begin the role of Reach More Coordinator here at the parish. I grew up at St. John's as a Jensen, attending the school K-8 and the youth group while in High School. I'm exceptionally grateful for the faith formation that I received growing up at the parish.

I went to the University of Minnesota and studied Biology in undergrad. While there, I became involved in the St. Lawrence Catholic Newman Center just off campus. I made phenomenal Catholic friends, experienced growth in my personal prayer life, and lived for 2 years in an intentional Household of Catholic women with morning prayer and weekly dinners together. These college years were essential in my growth and formation, and lit a fire in me to work for the Church.

I have been taking courses for the past 2 years at the St. Thomas School of Divinity, and will complete my Master's degree in Pastoral Ministry this December. Throughout my studies, I have developed a particular love for the complementarity of faith and science, and the role of the Catholic family as first parish (and parents as first catechists).

I got married last July to my husband whom I met at the Newman Center at the U. Dominic and I enjoy the outdoors, friendly (but competitive) games of cribbage, and adventuring with our black lab Oliver. We just bought a house in New Brighton last month and are excited to be parishioners at St. John's!

I have been a part of a small group consistently since high school and have experienced the great fruit that can come from walking through life together, reflecting on Scripture, and holding each other accountable in prayer and virtue. Small group environments are casual, inviting, and friendly! I'm excited to help cultivate these types of small groups at St. John's for participants and leaders in our training groups. I hope each and every parishioner will consider taking this step and saying "yes" to friendship and spiritual growth in a Reach More small group."

Chapel Renovation Update

Planning for our Chapel of the Angels renovation continues. The parish has contracted with parishioner Steve Arndorfer, owner of SMA Construction, to finalize construction plans, gather proposals and oversee the work once it begins, which could be as soon as this fall. We won't know exact renovation costs until Steve gathers more information, but we anticipate costs between \$150,000 and \$200,000.

A special thank you to parishioners and friends who have provided financial support for this renovation. So far, we have received over \$110,000 for this project! **We are very grateful**, as these gifts will bring our parish community closer to Jesus in the Eucharist **for generations to come**.

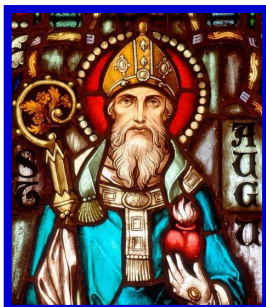

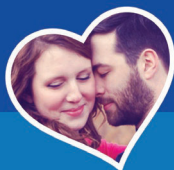

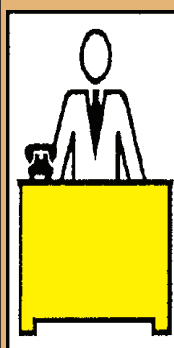
