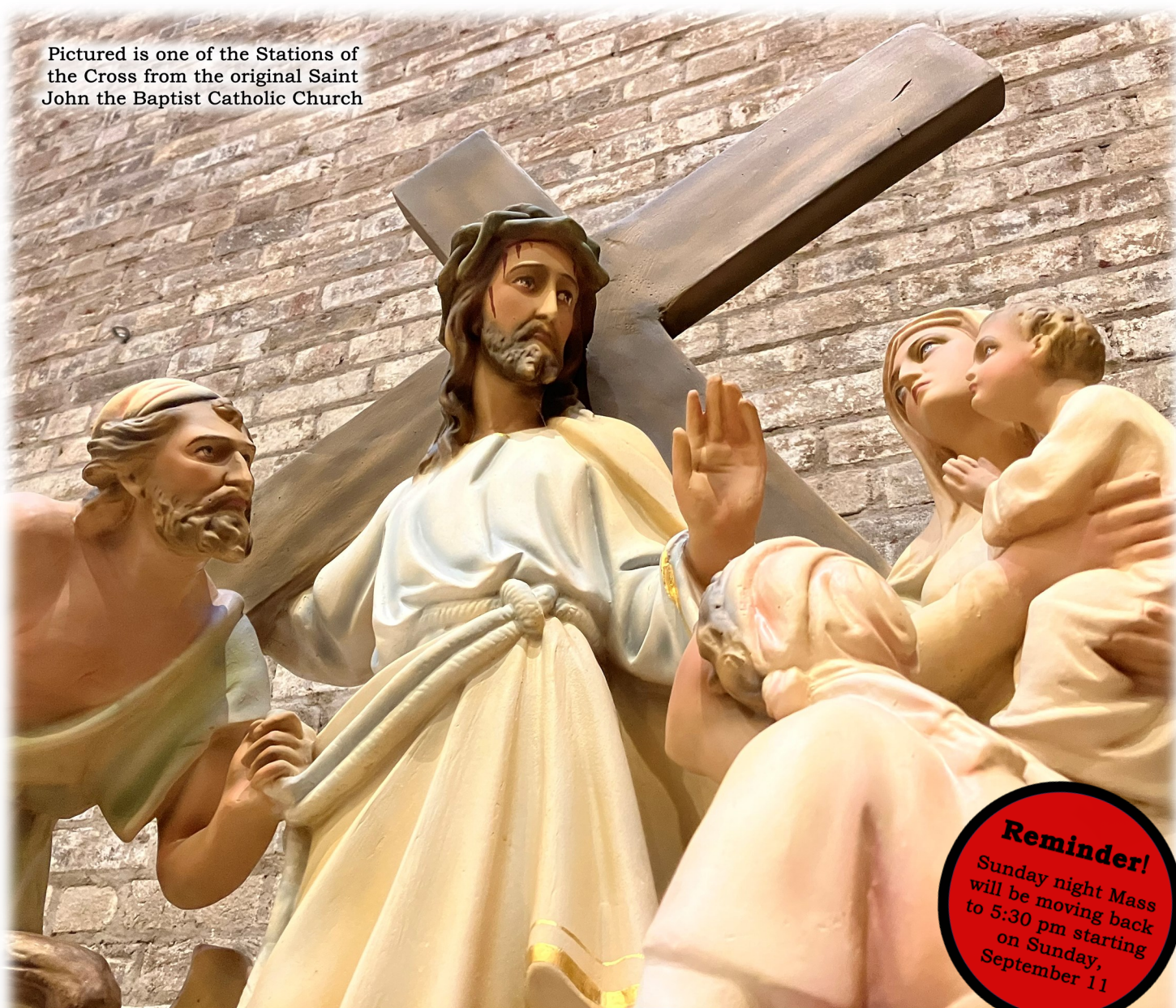

Last year FallFest was Restored to Life! It’s an event that builds community within our parish family as well as welcomes many new people, neighbors, friends and even some strangers. It was a huge success in many ways, more people engaging in the weekend, a lot of volunteers giving their time, and additional money in the budget to cover the amazing work we do as a parish. I don’t expect this year to be much different! Can you tell, I love this weekend!

The most significant victories last year were the hidden successes that only a few were privileged to witness. The power of a simple introduction, a relaxed conversation, and an intentional invitation. Many were invited into the “more” St. John’s has to offer. Two people were asked if they had ever considered becoming Catholic and with some gentle encouragement, they went through RCIA at St. John’s and became Catholic this past year. Look at what the Lord can do with the opportunities he places in front of us and when we listen to the Holy Spirits promptings.

This year we want more people to be prepared to make simple introductions, have relaxed conversations, and be more intentional with inviting others into our life in Christ at St. John’s. Rite of Christian Initiation for Children

RCIC (Rite of Christian Initiation of Children) is for children between ages 8 and 14 who have completed second grade and are looking to celebrate the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and First Reconciliation. Students who have been baptized and are in need of Eucharist and First Reconciliation are also welcomed. Parents accompany the child in the process with regular meetings. Youth also receive instruction with their peers by registering with the Family Formation or Middle School Formation programs.

Becoming Catholic RCIA

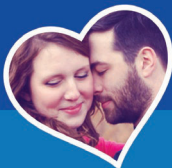

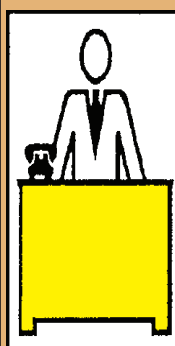
