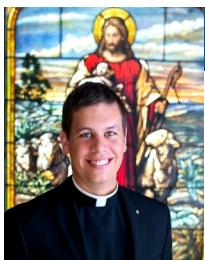

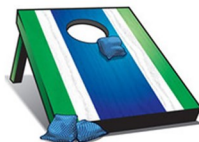

Sunday Giving Summary July/August 2022

- For the month of July 2022 Sunday Giving was 10% below budget; for August Sunday Giving was 1% above budget.
- For the fiscal year to date (July & August combined) we are 5% below budget.
- For comparison, last year Sunday Giving for July & August combined was 1.5% above budget.
- For the current fiscal year, 2022/23, we budgeted a 2.5% increase in Sunday Giving over actual 2021/22 giving.

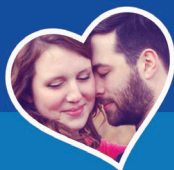

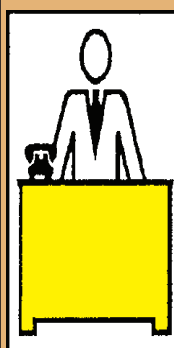
