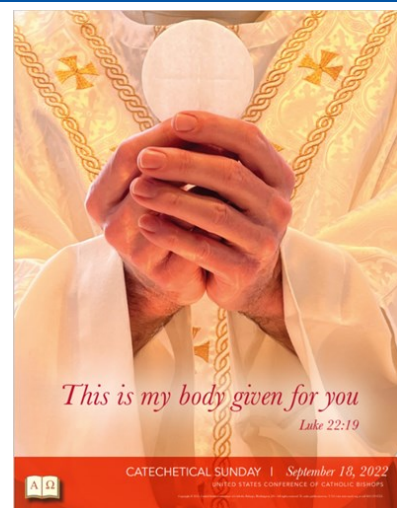

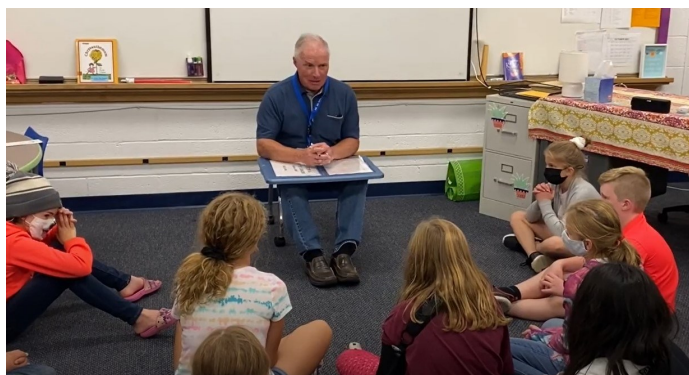

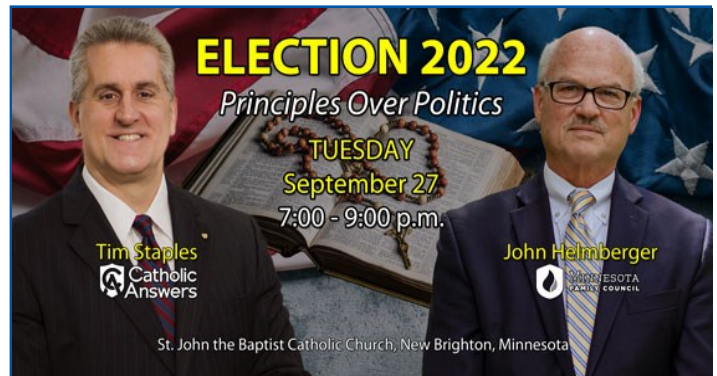

My brothers and sisters in Christ,

As many of you may know I had lung surgery and was treated for lung cancer (Ewings Sarcoma) in 2016 and 2017. After nearly 5 years of cancer free CT scans, I was told that the latest scan showed a tumor on the incision line from my past lung surgery. Last week a biopsy confirmed that my lung cancer had returned. My oncologist has ordered a series of tests and is consulting with other medical professionals to determine what the best treatment would be for the latest cancer. The good news is that the cancer is localized to the tumor, no cancer anywhere else in my body.

As you might expect, the diagnosis has me on an emotional roller coaster. In some ways, the latest diagnosis is scarier than the first time around. I humbly ask you to pray for me in this distressing time. Pray that I continue to put my trust in Christ, and that He will once again heal me. Pray that I have the strength to accept whatever happens.

I have a wonderful support group who pray for me and continue to help me be and stay positive. As in the past, your prayers, cards, and good wishes made the difference in my attitude and how I responded to treatment. I was truly humbled by the love you showed me.

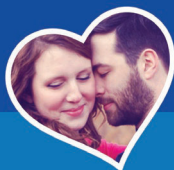

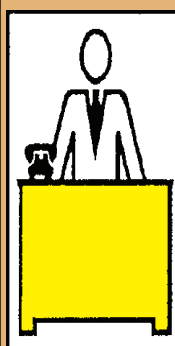
