However, they committed to following Christ as His disciples, and it forever changed their lives for the better.

Sunday Advent Series on the Mass

Beginning next weekend, we will be focusing on understanding the Mass, so that we can pray it well. Over the four Sundays of Advent, as well as the Holy Day of Obligation of the Immaculate Conception, we will focus on being Called Forth into Communion with Christ through the Mass. The themes are as follows:

1st Sunday of Advent: Called Forth into the Mass: Setting the stage and where the Mass comes from 2nd Sunday of Advent: Called Forth into the Liturgy of the Word: Understanding the importance of Scripture within the Mass

Immaculate Conception Holy Day: Called Forth to Receive: Learning from Mary to receive from God 3rd Sunday of Advent: Called Forth into the Liturgy of the Eucharist: Understanding the Sacrifice 4th Sunday of Advent: Called Forth to Live and Proclaim: Understanding the call to action Christmas Sunday: Called Forth into deeper communion with Christ who is WITH US

Our parish communications will provide some educational content on the Mass. The homilies, as well, will speak to the various aspects of the Mass and those corresponding themes. My hope is that through this intentional focus, every one of us will come to a deeper understanding of the Mass, be able to pray it more fully and be drawn deeper into communion with Christ.
