

- a) Sunday Giving is down 2% from prior year but is 1% above budgeted. We budgeted a 2.5% increase in Sunday Giving from 2021/22 to 2022/23. The differences you see here are due to timing of gifts and budget allocation. We continue to ask for your ongoing financial commitment to support our important ministries and operations. Thank you!
- b) For 2022/23 we budgeted for 335 K-8 students, while enrollment came in at 349. Enrollment for 2021/22 was 334. The school's growth is a blessing to the whole parish and a significant source of revenue.
 - Two drivers of increased Facility and Operation Costs are the fees required to sell the convent (\$21,890), which we booked as expense, and increased utility costs, which are 18% above prior year and 35% above budget. There
- are also some timing and budget allocations among the expenses that we will watch through the remainder of the year.
- d) Higher utility costs are impacting School Operating Expenses as well, at 18% above prior year and 29% above budget.

We trust in the Lord's providence in our finances, as he calls forth our generosity and we prudently monitor our expenses. We are grateful that our Sunday Giving has met our budget in these first six months. There is always reason to hope in the Lord! Thank you again for your ongoing generosity and commitment to our core values!


