Legacy Society (6:45) – Mary

- **Review current definition:** those who include St. John the Baptist in their will or estate plan, or name our parish as the beneficiary of a life insurance policy or retirement account.
 - Proposed revision: Add those who make an endowment gift of a particular amount during their lifetime.
 - Recommendation from Mark Dittman is cumulative giving of \$500 by endowment donors
- Additional thoughts: Consider all giving during one's lifetime as a way of creating a legacy.

*Discussed Mark Dittman's suggestion of using a cumulative amount of \$500 by endowment donors to be considered a member of the Legacy Society

*Area churches have varied base levels of \$1,000 to \$5,000

*Concerns on how to track and how donors want to be recognized were brought forward

*At the beginning of St. John's Legacy Society, there were some promises made of recognition that still need to be fulfilled.

*Suggested to have options of recognition to offer to members of the Legacy Society
