Capital Campaign – Led by Mary

- Planning study as follow-up to Weekend Experience Survey
- *The survey will give credibility with a fact sheet and an explanation of vision projects
- *Survey will be done in July and final report will be presented to parish leadership team in early August
- *Feasibility Study is the scope of the project and will confirm that we have the capacity for a capital campaign
- *Planning Study survey should be simple and easy to fill out
- *Suggestion to have the PDC be used to test survey
- *Survey should be offered in email and mailed formats
- *Offer a QR code that could be used on posters and bulletins for easy access to the survey
 - Secondary Projects in consideration
- *There is some concern that education and a definition of the Capital Campaign
- *The silent phase is when close relationships with stakeholders are being made
- *Announcement should come from Fr. Paul and Mary May, with Fr. Paul as the driver and Mary as the facilitator
- *Planning Study is written in announcements starting in June
- *Steier Group is providing examples and will be cleaning up our database
- *Suggested to be clear with communications

Sunday Giving – Led by Mary

- Should we devote a bulletin page and Mass announcement to "catching up" and Ways to Give?
- *Before we choose to ask or devote time to increase Sunday giving, we need to ask "Why are we short in the first place?"
- *There is data of trends and we should consider having a group of students from St. Thomas analyze our data
- *Which categories are down and why
- *Our message to the parish will change once we know more specifics

Donor Recognition Signs – Led by Mary
