- Church Interior & School Project Update. Members of the Administrative Services & Worship Commissions continue to meet with contractors to review options and discern the best path forward for our church interior needs. As shared previously, the main improvements we are considering are: exterior improvements (masonry & windows), addressing our ceiling and sound system, upgrades to our HVAC systems and pew refinishing. While we have initial budget numbers on these items, we are reviewing the scope of work for cost and effectiveness. Church and school leaders are also actively designing and planning our school restroom improvements, in addition to carpeting and our playground surface. Watch parish publications as our plans develop. And, please pray for the guidance of the Holy Spirit as we make these important decisions.

- Evangelization Events for Young Families: All Saints and Pumpkin Walk. Our annual onsite All Saints Party continues to grow in participation and volunteers. We had almost 200 children and parents dressed as saints and approximately 275 children overall. We also saw a growth in volunteers with the event and hosting ministry tables for the trick or treaters by 7 newly hosted tables. A new event this year was to host a trunk or treat at the New Brighton City hosted **Pumpkin Walk** on Saturday, November 21 at VETS park. The theme was All Saints with statues as decoration. We gave out baggies with a piece of candy and a sticker that say, "Shine God's Light-St. John the Baptist Catholic Church". About 800 families participated in this event for us to share about our church.
- Rite of Acceptance and Welcome for adults and confirmation students. Becoming Catholic RCIA Rite of Welcome & Acceptance will be celebrated on Saturday, November 18 at the 4:30pm Mass for adults. At this Rite, the catechumens (unbaptized) and candidates (baptized seeking full communion) publicly declare their intention to continue their journey toward full communion with the Catholic Church. Members of the parish community should affirm that they are ready to help and support the participants seeking to follow Christ by prayer and example. This year we are adding the **Rite of Welcome** for our confirmation students on Sunday, November 19 at 5:30pm Mass followed by a large group presentation for students, sponsors and parents. Keep in your prayers all who are entering the period of the catechumenate where they will learn about the power of the sacraments and the moral life of a disciple.
