I. Committee Status

- A. The Cemetery Committee has currently suspended meetings because of the pandemic. Any additional projects have been placed on hold and we have been dealing with items that need attention via email. The Landscaping Project was placed on hold and will revisit the project in the future.

II. Summary of Financial Activity

- A. Cemetery Committee Budget numbers remain in the black.
- B. Budget Items of Note:
 - 1. 10% of sales were sent to the Perpetual Care fund (endowment) in September 2020
 - 2. A new budget item for the 20/21 budget is a Property/Liability Insurance Expense representing the Cemetery's share of the yearly insurance cost incurred by SJB.

III. Projects Completed

- A. The Cemetery Committee completed the following projects in 2020.
 - 1. Drive lane repair occurred in September 2020
 - 2. A new sign was installed in October 2020.

IV. Cemetery Counts

- A. Unsold spaces include: 118 full body burial spaces, 148 Cremation in-ground spaces, 139 Columbarium niche spaces, and 63 infant burial spaces.
- B. The columbarium plaza is expandable up to 6 more cabinets. Concrete pads are already poured for the first two when we are ready to expand.
