- *A \$50,000 pledge was received for the School Operations Endowment
- *The Steier Group puts us at \$4.6 million in early projections
- *A matching fund strategy might be needed in early 2024
- *Campaign concludes at the end of January, 2024
- *Project updates will be coming in bulletins

- *We need to communicate with parishioners about the project, including adjustments in timeline, budget, and who is the point person
- *Be careful with timing of communication with parishioners. We don't want to discourage giving
- *School projects point person is Ann Laird
- *Church projects point person is Mark Dittman and Pat Hinnenkamp, with Administrative Services Commission advising
 - Report from captains (*Don, Steve*)
- *Each captain has 10-12 individuals to call
- *Not too many concerns on the need to have the campaign

- *Parishioners are supportive, positive, and half have already pledged
 - Timeline

 - ii. Commitment weekend
- *January 20 and 21 weekend will be used to collect the last pledges
 - a. Goals Workbook
 - a. Endowments
- *Will begin moving forward on communicating about six St. John's Endowments in February, 2024
- *Gifts are still coming in for the Tuition Assistance Endowment and the Cemetery Endowment
 - b. Vision for Development
- *Organize vision under "Generous Spirit" and include gifts of time and treasure
- *Start with smaller options of engagement and create awareness
- *Strengthen affirmation, show the fruits, go = engagement
- *Use Mass announcements more strategically
- *Create ways to further engagement past baptism, confirmation, and reconciliation
