

#### St. John the Baptist Youth Ministry Scholarships

St. John the Baptist Catholic Youth Ministry is blessed to have many generous supporters who give their time, energy, and money to make our ministry amazing. Through the generosity of our parish community during our annual Youth 365 fundraiser, we are able to offer a number of merit-based scholarships to students hoping to participate in our programs. To apply, fill out an application form, including your personal information and the scholarship(s) you would like to apply for. Students will need to write a short essay reflection on the corresponding prompt.

# St. Zechariah Liturgical Minister Scholarship

This scholarship is available for students who participate in our weekend liturgies as altar servers, ushers, greeters, eucharistic ministers, musicians, choir members or lectors. Students who apply for this scholarship should be on the schedule for a minimum of 5 liturgies. The greater the involvement, the greater the scholarship amount to be granted.

Prompt: How has your experience serving in the liturgy impacted you and our parish community?

# St. Mary Early Childhood Volunteer Scholarship

This scholarship is available for students who volunteer at Sunday School, Childcare, Sunday Nursery, VBS and other programs within our parish that involve caring for young children. Students who apply should have served a minimum of 5 times. The more service you've done, the greater the scholarship amount to be granted.

Prompt: How has your experience caring for or catechizing young children impacted you and the children?

### St. Martha Parish Service Scholarship

This scholarship is available for students who serve at community events throughout the year. These events include but are not limited to: Fall Fest, All Saints Party, Journey to the Inn, Egg Hunt, Youth 365, Night of Gratitude, Waffle Breakfast, Turkey Dinner, etc. The scholarship amount may vary depending on the number of events that the student has served at. They should ask an adult who they have served under to be their reference.

Prompt: How has your experience serving at parish events impacted you and our parish community?

### St. Paul Bible Study Scholarship

This scholarship is available for students who participate in Wednesday Night Bible Study and have an attendance of 75% or higher. They should ask their bible study leader to be a reference for them.

Prompt: How have you grown in familiarity with scripture, relationship with God and community with one another through your experience of Wednesday Night Bible Study?

### St. Timothy Discipleship Scholarship

This scholarship is available for students who participate in a discipleship group (middle school or high school) and have an attendance of 75% or higher. They should ask their discipleship group leader to be their reference.

Prompt: How has being in a discipleship group benefited you and the other members of your group?

### St. Luke the Evangelist Scholarship



This scholarship is available for students who have invited friends who were not already involved, to participate in a youth ministry event or program. This could be middle school youth group, high school youth group, dgroup, Wednesday Night Bible Study, or camp.

Prompt: Why did you invite your friend to participate in a youth ministry event, how did it go, and how do you think your friend has benefited from it?

#### **Financial Aid**
