- Year-to-Date Sunday Giving. Our mission is enabled by so many of our parishioners who live out of a generous spirit with their financial support. As of Week 37 (March 10) in our fiscal year (July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024) we are \$17,009, or 1%, above our year-to-date projected budget in Sunday Giving. This is significant considering that we budgeted a 3.6% increase in Sunday Giving this year over fiscal 2022/23. Your generosity is making that happen! Thank you!
- Church Interior Projects. We have signed the contract with JT Egner Construction to spray the ceiling, upgrade our HVAC, refinish our pews, install a new sound system and clean our terrazzo floor, all set to begin the week of May 6.
