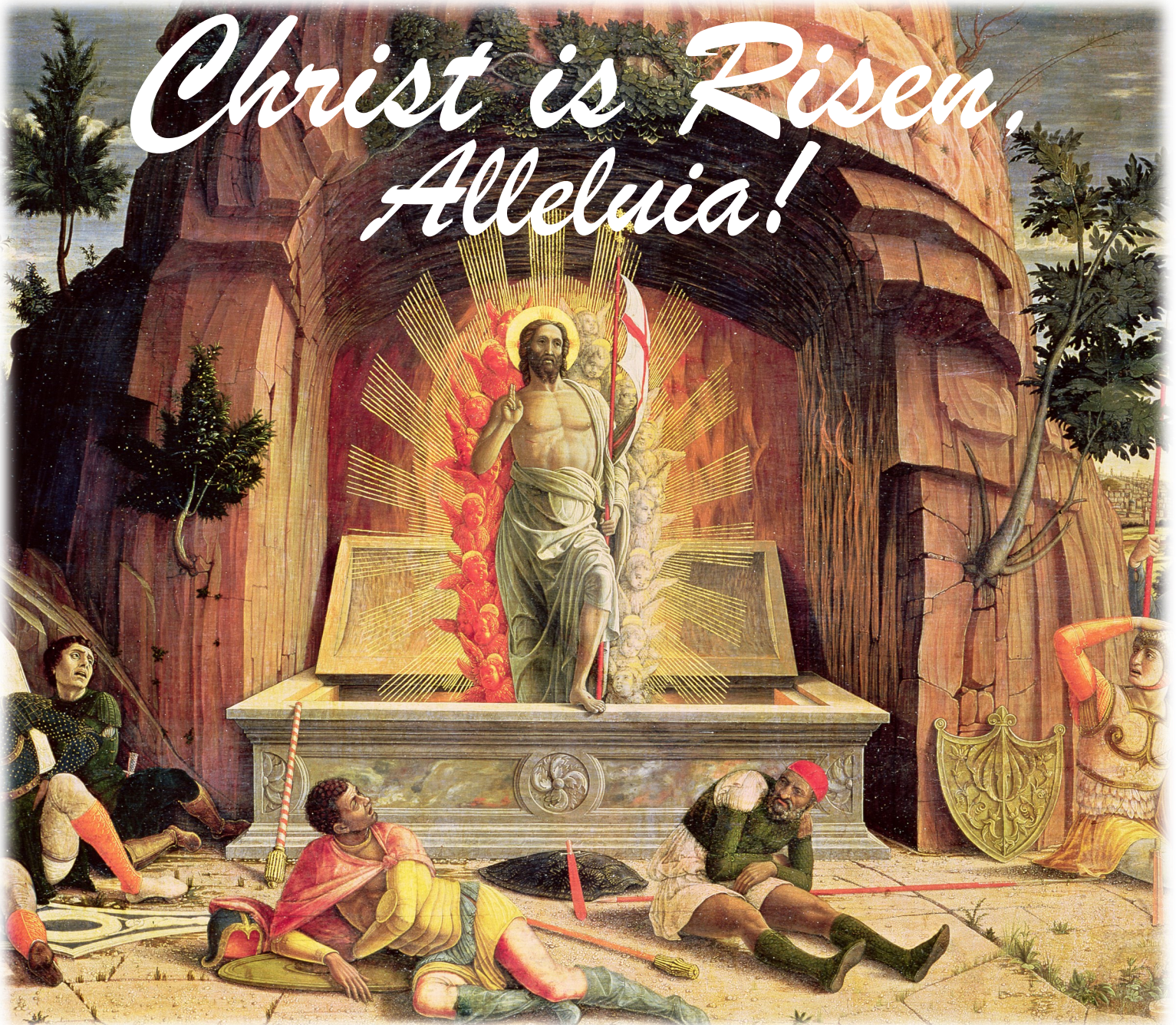

Finally, thank you for your commitment to our Restore to Gather Campaign! We have reached over \$4.75 million in pledges, well on our way to our \$5 million goal. The main portions of the work on the church will begin after First Holy Communion and will take about 6 months to complete. The school projects will begin in the summer. It is an exciting time in the life of our parish and I appreciate your commitment to helping us restore our campus so that we can help the Risen Jesus be encountered here for generations to come!

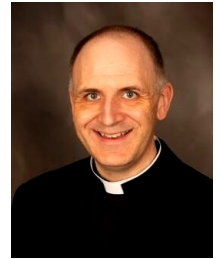
Youth 365 Resurrection Feast – April 7, 9 am-12:30 pm
