Youth 365 Weekend

Christ is risen, Alleluia!! He is risen indeed, Alleluia! Today we celebrate the 8th day of Easter, Divine Mercy Sunday, one of my all-time favorite feasts. Jesus meets the Apostles where they are at, in their struggle, their confusion, their doubt, and he reveals himself as the resurrected savior. For the next 40 days, he appears to them, building their faith in him before he commissions them to "Go therefore, and make disciples of all nations…teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you." This is where we get our rally cry--Go. Make. Teach.

My name is Sarah Wilder and my job is to coordinate discipleship for our youth! What a fascinating job title, am I right?! My whole job is to support our young people and help them to become mature disciples of Jesus! What a privilege!

This year, I have been investing in many generous adult volunteers and supporting them as they "go" and "make" disciples of our youth, "teaching" them to observe all that Jesus has commanded us. In my short time here, I have been focused on shifting our ministry from event-based ministry to discipleship making ministry. We still have events, but those events flow from and feed into our discipleship focused environments. Despite being short-staffed for most of this year, we have seen tremendous growth in several key areas.

- First, we see **participation in discipleship groups increased** from 4 to 14 for high schoolers (that's 250% growth!) and from 7 to 29 for middle schoolers (314% growth!).
- Second, we see **participation in our middle school formation program has grown** from 26 at the start of last year to 40 this year (that's 54% growth!) Students report tremendous individual growth in their familiarity with scripture, their relationship with God, and their friendships with one another.
- Third, we see that **students from many different schools are coming together** and building community. We serve students from over 15 different schools including public, Catholic, charter, and homeschool. Together, we form one SJB community.

How is this possible? How have we seen so much growth? With the tremendous support from our priests, parents, youth ministry volunteers and our whole parish community! With the grace and guidance of the Holy Spirit! With an abundance of financial resources provided to our ministry! This weekend is our annual fundraiser for youth ministry! The funds collected today will be used to 1) provide scholarship opportunities for our youth to attend camps, retreats, and programs 2) purchase quality resources and materials for our ministries and 3) renovate and update the youth room so that our youth are learning and growing in a beautiful and functional environment.

While there is still quite a lot of growth to be had, I am confident that our students are being challenged to be better disciples of Jesus each day and can't wait to see how they mature in the years to come! Your donations help to make that possible. Please consider supporting us by grabbing an envelope and returning it to the collection basket or welcome desk. You can also make a donation online by selecting Youth Ministry in the drop down menu.





Who is participating in St. John's Youth Ministry?

- 84 unique middle schoolers from 12 different schools have attended youth events this year!
- 29 middle schoolers are in discipleship groups of 5-8 teens with 1-2 adult mentors!
- 40 middle schoolers are active in Wednesday Night Bible Study!
- 40 high schoolers are receiving confirmation this year from 6 different schools!
- 40 unique high schoolers have participated in our youth events this year!
- 14 high schoolers are in discipleship groups of 6-8 teens with 2 adult mentors!
- 28 adult volunteers serving in our various ministries!



What are we doing?

- Monthly events for middle schoolers and high schoolers
- Weekly and biweekly discipleship groups for middle school and high school students
- Weekly youth formation at Wednesday Night Bible Study and Confirmation
- Winter Faith Camp, Summer Camp, Totus Tuus



What have we been using the money for?

- Sending kids to camps and retreats!
 - o 23 youth were offered scholarships for summer camp last year!
 - o 7 youth were offered scholarships for winter faith camp this year!
 - This year, we expanded our scholarship program to bless parishioners based on their parish involvement. We expect about 50% of participants to receive a scholarship, which would be doubled from last year!
- Covering the cost of our regular programs for students who can't afford the fee!
- Purchasing quality resources and materials for our programs!
 - o Purchased: 50 new bibles!
- Updating the youth room!
 - o Complete: new carpet, new floors, new furniture and games, and lighting updates!
 - o Upcoming: sound absorbing panels, and a youth room kitchen!
