- 3. Review the Vetting Process. Mary has some questions before changes get approved.
 - a. We have in the paperwork that if you want to be vetted to be approved for a mission, then you need to do it between the times that we are meeting September through June.

b. To allow three months for that vetting process to happen, that's fine and it makes sense, unless you have somebody like we had a couple of people this year who said "Would you support my going on mission to such and such, like a college mission, they don't have that kind of time to wait on us to vet. So, what do we do in that situation? Do we just say no; that's hardly seems fair.

Jane: that's when you probably have to break it into 'Are you trying to have an ongoing funding request or is this a one-time only. If it were a one-time only then you could probably parse down to process of vetting.

Mary: if we take Megan as an example, the person who asked for the help. She's going through Franciscan University so we already who that is and whether we trust them, so we don't have to do all their paperwork.

Jane: the whole idea is to say that this person has not gone through the entire St. John's vetting process, but we are comfortable relying on this person for this one time. Because part of the reason that we did this is due to liability.
